- **Cornerstone's Immigration Mission Something to Think About** Delaney Hall is a federal immigration detention center in New Jersey. Members of Congress have the legal authority to show up at the facility and conduct oversight inspections. However, they have been stopped on multiple occasions by ICE agents. After finally being allowed to visit Delaney Hall, a Senator from New Jersey said, "The majority of the people we encountered have no criminal charges." The governor of New Jersey, Mikie Sherrill, attempted to enter the facility Memorial Day as some detainees began a hunger strike because of spoiled food containing maggots, but the governor was denied entry. Hebrews 13:3 "Continue to remember those in prison as if you were together with them in prison."
- **Reconciling Ministries Network** There are seeds of grace hidden in every life. Some grow quietly. Some break through hard ground. May we tend one another with patience and hope, trusting that God is always growing something beautiful among us.
