- **Cornerstone's Immigration Mission Something to Think About** At the Winn Correctional Center in Louisiana, which houses 1500 ICE detainees, investigators found multiple use of force instances that did not fully comply with standards according to a report from the Homeland Security Office of the Inspector General. A surprise federal inspection found a prohibited chokehold, an officer who had stabbed a detainee with a pen and other issues that threatened the health and safety of the detainees.
