- **Cornerstone's Immigration Mission Something to Think About** Recent US immigration news is dominated by the administration's aggressive crackdown, which has expanded to target both undocumented immigrants and legal pathways to green cards, resulting in major deportations, a spike in detention center populations, and significant protest. The Department of Homeland Security has drastically ramped up deportations and increased the number of ICE officers. The administration has also struck controversial deals with several African and Latin American nations, such as Sierra Leone, to accept third-country deportees. Proverbs 29:4 "By justice a king gives a country stability, but those who are greedy for bribes tear it down."

- **Reconciling Ministries Network**  Pride Month commemorates the struggle for civil rights and the ongoing pursuit of equal justice under the law for the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer community, as well as the accomplishments of LGBTQ individuals. Love calls us by name and invites us to follow. Not because we are perfect, but because we are beloved. May we trust that there is room for each of us in God's story and may we have courage enough to answer love's call.
