- **Cornerstone's Immigration Mission Something to Think About** The first prominent arrivals of Haitian boat refugees seeking asylum in South Florida began around 1972 because of political turmoil. Then a devastating earthquake struck Haiti in January 2010 prompting the US government to grant fleeing Haitians Temporary Protected Status (TPS). Recently the U. S. Supreme Court ruled to end TPS for Haitians. TPS did not provide those immigrants a green card or a clear path to citizenship. Many Haitians, if deported, would face hardship and perhaps death due to political unrest in Haiti. Luke 6:36 "Therefore, be merciful, even as your father is also merciful."
- **Reconciling Ministries Network**  When the path ahead feels uncertain, may we remember that faith is not certainty but trust. May we take the next faithful step, confident that Love walks beside us.
